Assignment

1. Click the link above to the code-exambpe to get to the W3School-TryOut area.
2. Save the code with a suitable name, such as LU05.S13.html.
3. Have it run by clicking the *run-button*.
4. Move the v-show from div-tag into the text-tag. Change the variable in the /script-area from showDiv to showText - Add into your p-tag a attribute v-if. The corresponding variable for that v-if is called showImage which can also contain the values true and false. - Now we can seperately control the visibility of the text and image ressource. - Try out all four values for the showText and showImage.
