Assignments

1. Open the playground with the link above. You will be presented with a split window on which on the right hand side you will see the coding area, and on the right hand side the result area.
2. Currently there is a *Hello World* message with a lightgreen background.
3. Change the already existing text *Hello Galaxy* with a lightblue background
4. Execute the change by pushing the *RUN-Button*
5. Check the result
