1. Go to the JetBrains website and log in with your credentials.
2. Download the software version for your PC.
3. Commence the installation process (as shown in the video-tutorials)
4. Once the installation is complete, start the post-installation steps.
5. Open the command line/terminal on your notebook and connect to the database as shown in the video tutorials.
6. Finally, request a response from the database by entering „SELECT sysdate;“. If you have carried out all the steps correctly, the database will respond with the current date and time of your PC.
7. Thank God that you have succeeded. Otherwise, pray to God for inspiration AND a lot of patience to find the error.
