6. Finally, request a response from the database by entering „SELECT sysdate;“. If you have followed all the steps correctly, the database will respond with the current date and time of your PC.
7. If you succeeded, be humble and grateful and help those in need. If not, seek the wisdom of your it-master (teacher).
