- The DBMS is a piece of software that manages the data.
- It consists of pre-programmed functions, that help managing the data.
- Without the DBMS companies such as Zalando or Digitech would not be able to store goods or deliver them to their customers.

4. What is stored in the DB? How is it stored? Give an example?

- In databases basically the data is stored in tables that are linked to each other.
- This is done to avoid unintentional redundancies within the database.
- Each table (entity type: e.g. persons) is composed of columns (attributes: e.g. name, birthdate) and rows (entities: e.g. Max Müller, 12.11.1989)
